Driving Directions

The Woods Hole Golf Club is located at the southwestern tip of Cape Cod, approximately 25 minutes from the Bourne Bridge.

FROM THE BOURNE BRIDGE

At the rotary on the Cape side of the bridge, take Route 28 South approximately 12 miles. The road narrows to two lanes. Continue straight through the first light for 2/3 of a mile, bear right at sign for Woods Hole.

Go 1 1/2 miles and at traffic light, turn right onto Quissett Harbor Road.
Go 75 yards, take your first left onto Quissett Avenue.
Go 1.1 miles and the entrance to the Woods Hole Golf Club is on the right.

FROM THE SAGAMORE BRIDGE

If you are traveling to the Cape over the Sagamore Bridge, take exit 1, turn left at the second set of lights.

Go approximately 2 1/2 miles to the Bourne Rotary, then follow the above directions.
